General Requirements:

### 1. Regular and frequent access to a computer.

- Windows or Mac
- A modern web browser: Microsoft Internet Explorer 7 (or later) or Mozilla Firefox 2.0 (or later)
- Your browser needs to have a recent version of Adobe Flash Player (version 8 or later)  
(If you can view videos at sites such as youtube.com, your system will be fine)
- A word processor capable of saving Microsoft Word files  
(e.g. Microsoft Word, Open Office – <http://www.openoffice.org>)
- Media software (e.g. Microsoft Windows Media Player or equivalent) capable of playing MP3 files.
- Adobe Reader (Version 6 or later) or an equivalent viewer for PDF files.

Note: Some particular courses (e.g. Software Design and Development) may require special software (see below). You should check those requirements before enrolling.

### 2. An Internet connection

You'll be regularly accessing a virtual learning environment to use learning materials, download reading material, contribute to discussions and more! Your experience in this is largely dependent on the speed of your Internet connection.

Will dialup be OK? All courses expect you to participate in online audio conferences or to download video content. Therefore, dialup will **not** be sufficient.

Our recommendation is a broadband connection at least 256Kbps (all ADSL connections are at least this fast).

Where possible, SCIL supports the use of free or Open Source software, minimising the financial impact on the learning of all students.

### Special Hardware and Software Requirements for Software Design and Development

You will need to have **Microsoft Visual C# 2008, Express Edition**, installed on a computer that you have access to (i.e. at home/school or where you intend on programming). ### For interest only mode

Courses may also be taken on a "for interest only" mode. Assessment tasks will not be marked and there is no requirement to sit examinations. Courses taken in this mode would not count towards the Preliminary or Higher School Certificate. A two unit course taken in a "for-interest only" mode would cost \$500. This mode may be of interest to parents and/or mature-aged students.

### Refunds
